Requirements:

- You must be a United States citizen.
- You must be eligible to qualify at the GS-9 level. To qualify, you must have a Master's degree, PhD, JD or higher-level degree from an accredited college or university. You may also qualify with a Bachelor's degree with 1 year of specialized experience related to the career track for which you are applying.
