Centralized Summer Intern

Department of Defense

The Department of Defense (DOD) Centralized Summer Intern Program is a paid internship for post secondary (college) students from two- and four-year accredited institutions of higher education. Participation in the program will promote experiential training opportunities to student interns in the DOD. The goal of the program is to integrate academic theory with workplace experience that may serve as a pipeline to the student employment programs and entry-level employment opportunities within DOD. The program is designed to improve opportunities for college students to prepare for their transition to the workplace, and to foster human resource diversity in DOD.



In your position as a Centralized Summer Intern you will:

- Participate in on-site work experience, furthering knowledge of the work force and opportunities within the DOD.

Requirements:

- You must be a U.S. citizen.
- You must be enrolled in a two- or four-year accredited institution of higher education.
- You must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale.
