### **In your position as a Social Worker you will:**

- Use psychological/social casework and group therapy techniques to gain perspective on the patient, the problem, the expressed and implied needs, and functioning level, to provide therapy.
- Formulate treatment goals for individual patients that need casework prescriptions.
- Conduct family therapy when indicated, and maintain liaison with Family Advocacy Program Coordinator in cases where spouse/child abuse is related to substance abuse.
- Use the full range of professional psychological/social work techniques to provide psychological, social, vocational counseling, and therapy during the rehabilitation.
- Consult with commander and other key personnel to discuss substance abuse issues and to develop appropriate unit rehabilitation plans.

### **Requirements:**

- You must be a United States citizen.
- You must have a master's degree in social work in a school accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.
- You must have be a licensed social worker by the recognized licensing agency of a State, the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, or the U.S. Virgin Islands. This licensure must allow for independent clinical practice.
