Foreign Service Security Technical Specialists (STSs) are support personnel within the Bureau of Diplomatic Security who assist in worldwide technical security programs. These programs provide protection for Department of State facilities and personnel from technical espionage, acts of terrorism, and crime. In this protection effort, sophisticated electronic and electromechanical security systems are used throughout the world. STS personnel report to Security Engineering Officers who provide overall program management on technical security matters department-wide.



In your position as a Service Security Technical Specialist you will:

- Repair technical security systems.
- Use sophisticated electronic test equipment.
- Travel to overseas embassies and consulates.
- Test new generation technical security equipment.
- Assist in technical aspects of criminal investigations.
